






PROJECT AIM

- •The aim is to strengthen and digitize the primary school curriculum (Grade 1-4) through widespread and experiential learning-based methodologies, thereby enhancing students' learning experiences. These methodologies, which include the integration of digital technologies alongside traditional classroom settings, aim to diversify students' learning processes and provide a more effective learning environment
- •Widespread learning methods have the potential to diversify lesson materials to suit students' different learning styles and needs, making the learning process more interactive. Experiential learning, on the other hand, adopts an approach where students actively engage and gain learning experiences through real-world problems. By implementing this project, the goal is to increase students' learning motivation, help them learn information more permanently, and develop better problem-solving skills. In this way, the aim is to create a more qualitative educational environment by supporting students' academic achievements and personal development.


